Harley, R.M., Antar, G.M. & Giulietti, A.M. (2019) Erratum for “*Stachytarpheta atkinsiae*, A new species of Verbenaceae endemic to the Chapada Diamantina, Bahia, Brazil” *Phytotaxa* 401 (2): 127–132.

When publishing *Stachytarpheta atkinsiae* Harley & Giul. (Harley *et al.* 2019:128) we inadvertently cited the incorrect collection number. According to Article 9.2 of the Shenzhen Code (Turland *et al.* 2018), this error needs to be corrected, as below.

***Stachytarpheta atkinsiae* Harley & Giul. sp. nov.** Figures 1 a–m; 2A–C; MAP1. Type:—BRAZIL. Bahia: Mucugê, Serra do Gobira, ca. 8,4 km ao sul de Mucugê em linha reta, na última subida próxima ao cume, 13° 04'26"S, 41°22'44"W, 1555 m. Campo rupestre entre pedras, 19 January 2005, R.M. Harley, A.M. Giulietti & E. Ribeiro 55388 (holotype HUEFS; Isotypes K, MG, SPF).
